David Brandt is a soil health pioneer who farms in Fairfield County in central Ohio. He began no-till farming in 1971 and has been using cover crops since 1978. David has participated in yield plots for corn, soybeans and wheat into various cover crops. David has received numerous awards for conservation practices.



Allen Williams is a 6th generation family farmer whose major areas of research and business focus include soil health, cover crop/livestock integration, adaptive forage & grazing management, high attribute pasture-based meat production, and alternative marketing systems. He has consulted with more than 4200 farmers and ranchers in the United States, Canada, Mexico, and South America .



Joe Breker is a North Dakota soil health advocate and over 35 year no-till farmer. His operation includes a diverse crop rotation, cover crops, as well as nutrient management practices. Mr. Breker was the recipient of the National Nutrient Management Award in 2015.
