

Reis Ranch Tour highlights: Range health, rest/rotation, May calving, erosion control structures, cedar tree control, pasture grub control, artesian well management

Totton Angus Tour highlights: Range health, production, water infiltration, mob grazing, fence line weaning, winter grazing

The Mid Missouri River Prescribed Burn Association is comprised of landowner volunteers dedicated to reclaiming rangeland and pasture along the Missouri River from the encroachment of cedar trees that threaten rangeland ecology and ranch profitability. Presentation and tour will focus on all aspects of cooperation in preparing for and implementing prescribed fire for cedar tree control.
