Standing Butte Ranch was established in 2016 when Turner Enterprises bought what was previously part of the historic Triple U ranch. Goals upon the acquisition were to implement planned grazing, restore degraded areas, and foster native plant communities. Standing Butte Ranch uses holistic management principles to raise quality bison animals, maintain healthy ecological function on grasslands, and offer a high-quality work environment to employees.

This walk will show attendees areas that are showing ecological shift back to primarily native grasses, discussion on soil characteristics, and water infiltration demonstration.

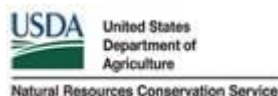
Directions:
