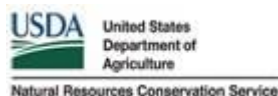

We will meet at the farm 18468 424th Ave, Willow Lake, SD 57278 at 10 AM. From Willow Lake travel about 5 miles west to 424th Ave (County Rd 46) and then go about 5.3 miles north to the farmstead. From Clark off Hwy 212, travel south on S. Smith St which is 424th Ave (County Rd 46) south about 11.5 miles.
