Dean and Candice Operate a custom grazing operation in Ree Heights, South Dakota, where they have implemented planned grazing practices to better manage their grass resource. Much of the grass pasture that they now graze was once farm ground that was planted back to grass in the early 2000's. Dean and Candice are currently grazing one herd of 1100 stockers.

At this pasture walk we will focus on everything that goes along with running large groups of livestock in one herd. What happens to our plant communities, our soils, and our livestock in this kind of system? We will also touch on what Dean and Candice do when it comes to encroachment of non native species and noxious weeds.

The meeting spot will be south of Ree Heights on 349th ave. Heading south take the first right after you cross 199th street.

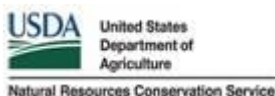
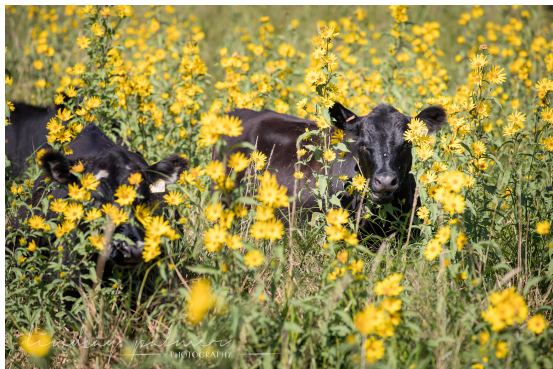
You can use the address shown to the right in your navigation system, but navigation had been known to stop you about 1/2 mile before you reach the destination.
